STARTER	Have learners say or sing the alphabet song. Ask learners to identify the two types of letters in the English alphabet? (Answer: consonants and vowels) Recap with learners to find out what they already know about consonants. Share the performance indicators with learners and introduce the lesson.					
PHASE 2: NEW LEARNING	Brainstorm learners for the meaning of consonant. Write the letters of the alphabet on the board or cardboard. Let learners identify all the consonants sounds in the alphabet. Example: /b/, /f/, /g/, /c/, /d/, /t/, /n/, /m/ Mention and write some words on the board and guide learners to identify consonants in the words. Let learners produce the consonants sounds in their local language. e.g. /b/, /f/, /g/, /c/, /d/, /t/, /n/, /m/. etc. Have learners mention words in their local language that begins with /b/, /f/, /g/, /c/, /d/, /t/, /n/, /m/ Record and write the vowel sounds of your language on the board or on flash cards. 	Engage learners to say tongue twisters to aid them pronounce words with consonants sounds.
	Example: "Teacher Tenten To Tarkoradi"
	Guide learners to pronounce consonants sounds correctly in connected speech.
	Assessment 1. What is a consonants sound? 2. List 10 words that contain consonants sound.
PHASE 3: REFLECTION	Use peer discussion and effective questioning to find out from learners what they have learnt during the lesson.
